

From coast to coast, our nationwide community winners have been announced!

Round Five of the *With One Voice* Social Franchise Start-up funding is now open.

Creativity Australia has awarded two community organisations with start-up grants to start their own *With One Voice* programs to build community wellbeing and prevent social isolation.

Round Five of the *With One Voice* Social Franchise Start Up fund is open for applications from today until the 1st of March.

Local community groups, social businesses and not-for-profits wanting to promote social inclusion and tackle loneliness, isolation and disadvantage in their community are invited to apply. Additionally, each successful applicant joins a 12-month intensive mentoring program.

The two successful community organisations to receive seed grants in Round Four to start up a new *With One Voice* program are:

- *The "Bridge"* Werribee Baptist Church from Victoria, and
- *LHAC (Let's Have a Chat) Inc.* from Queensland's Gold Coast.

Each of these organisations are located in significantly disadvantaged areas, diverse in culture and nationality. They provide crucial interventions for people with physical and/or mental disabilities and support to those directly and indirectly affected by mental illness and other challenges.

Most importantly, these organisations recognise how singing in a group can be transformative, inspire personal growth and create community wellbeing and inclusion. They each presented a strong social franchise offer that will be successful and sustainable. The choirs will create new social connections and extend opportunities for people of all ages and backgrounds living in these multi-cultural communities to participate and develop new skills and employment and improve wellbeing.

Founder & CEO of Centre for Hope in Windale, Geraldine Moran, , says "*With One Voice* perfectly encapsulates the unity we want to create for our community. The impact of loneliness and depression on our health

Research has found that lacking social connections is as damaging to our health as smoking 15 cigarettes a day and people experiencing social isolation have an average of 29% increased mortality (Holt-Lunstad, 2010 & 2015). Furthermore, 8 in 10 Australians think our society is becoming lonelier, while 6 in 10 say they often feel lonely (Lifeline 2016).

With One Voice Social Franchise

Creativity Australia is passionate about nurturing communities across Australia and beyond to sing together in the spirit of joy, wellbeing and inspiration. We are therefore delighted to offer a suite of *With One Voice* "how to" guide videos, resources and mentoring for individuals, groups and communities looking to start new, inclusive *With One Voice* choirs using our innovative social franchise model. We have also commenced a Conductor Development Program and have developed a *With One Voice* Start-up Fund to provide small grants to enable community leaders from around Australia to commence programs and replicate our model.

Our impact

Swinburne University evaluation showed 98% of *With One Voice* choir participants experienced less stress, 91% improved social bonds, 66% felt less depressed, 70% gained new skills for work life and 70% gained increased understanding & appreciation of diversity.

Creativity Australia received the 2016 Melbourne Award for our Contribution to the Community. The program has also been named in Anthill's SMART 100 most innovative organisations for the past 5 years.
