2. Please tell us what makes your local community unique and able to set up a *With One Voice* program. Include demographics, specific disadvantage experienced, similar programs, other organisations that might be interesting in partnering with you to deliver this program.
3. Who will help you achieve a sustainable program? Please share with us a plan and timeline outlining how you will find local supporters to help you set up the *With One Voice* program, including setting up a local organising and fundraising committee. Include potential stakeholders you are connected to or already have on board such as the local government, business and community leaders etc. Please also tell us if you have a conductor, venue or supper provider already engaged, who they are and why they will be a good partner to help implement the *With One Voice* program.
4. What other financial and in-kind support will you and your community provide towards this program in the first year and subsequent years?
5. If successful in your application, where would you like to see your *With One Voice* program in 2 years? How would it operate, who would be involved and what would be some of its key achievements?
6. Creativity Australia is offering a limited number of seed funding grants to establish *With One Voice* community choirs across Australia. Please advise if you would like to be considered for one of these grants and why.
