Background

The With One Voice program is set up in local communities through a social franchise model that empowers local communities to 'own' their own programs from the beginning. The 12-month mentoring program starts with an intensive 4-month process to establish the local partnership model and the launch the program. Following this period we have an on-going, monthly mentoring session where program metrics are reviewed and support provided to target key areas of weakness. At the end of the initial 12-month mentoring program, the local communities continue to have access to Creativity Australia mentors on an as-needs basis.

Over the next two years we will be establishing between 20-30 new choirs that are supported by part-time mentors.

The Role

We are looking for people who have experienced the benefits of the *With One Voice* program and who would like to be trained to mentor other communities to start their program.

Mentoring is conducted by telephone or Skype and thus has incredible flexibility. Likewise, the training will be done remotely.
