LUNCH & REFRESHMENTS

- A light lunch of sandwiches and drinks will be provided between 12.30pm and 2.00pm in the Swanston Hall (one level down from the main stage).
- No other food is allowed on site, aside from small snacks, like muesli bars, that will fit in your handbag.
- Please bring your own water bottle.

DRESS CODE & HOUSEKEEPING

- Everyone must wear a *With One Voice* t-shirt with your bottom half all in black (black pants or black skirt and tights) with black shoes. No bare legs, long sleeved tops under your t-shirt or sneakers please.
- No handbags, mobile phones or lyric sheets on stage please.
- Personal items may be kept in the Swanston Hall during the day. Even though we will have a security officer on duty, please do not bring valuables with you.
- As some choir members experience respiratory issues, please do not use strong perfumes or hairspray before or during your time at the Melbourne Town Hall. (However, for the sake of your fellow singers, cleanliness and deodorant is a must!)

SPECIAL NEEDS

- To help us make the day go smoothly for everyone, please ensure you have informed *With One Voice* HQ of any special needs (including mobility, anxiety or dietary requirements), even if you think we know you well. Contact us ASAP on (03) 8679 6088 or enquiries@cal.org.au.
- Special Needs Coordinator Katie Clarke will be available to assist those of you who need extra care to help make you more comfortable during the concert. If you are attending with a carer, please ensure they are introduced to Katie.
- There are disabled toilets on the 1st and 3rd floors of the Melbourne Town Hall.

DROP-OFF POINT / WHEELCHAIR & DISABLED ACCESS

- **CHOIR:** In the morning, everyone must enter the Melbourne Town Hall via the Collins Street side entrance, where there is a wheelchair ramp. The Collins Street entrance will be closed at showtime.
- **AUDIENCE:** A wheelchair ramp and lift is located on the left hand side of the main entrance on Swanston Street. The Swanston Street entrance will be closed in the morning.
