Choirs, like all community-based activities, face an on-going struggle to ensure their project remains viable and sustainable while also meeting the needs of its community.

With One Voice has a membership contribution model that we have seen create sustainable choirs around the country.

As an inclusive choir, our number 1 priority is that NO-ONE is unable to participate due to inability to pay. This is central to our ethos and operations.

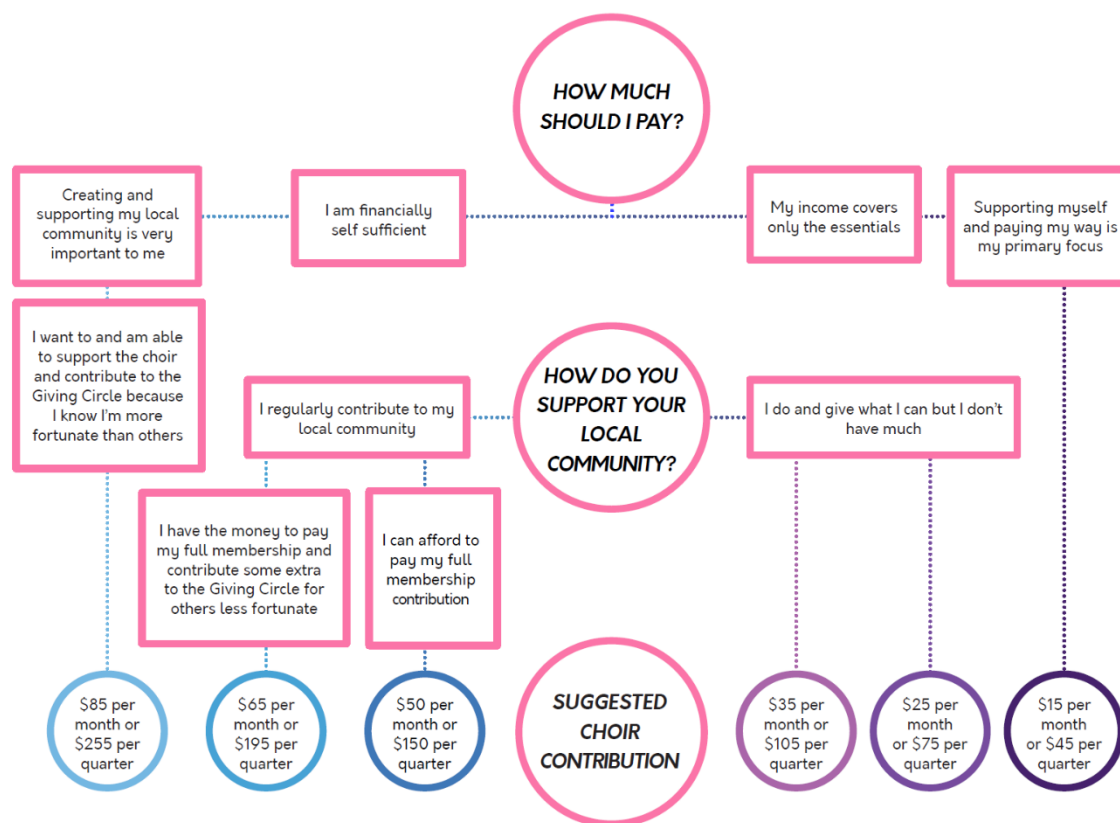
The challenge then is to have enough people who do and can contribute.

This is also a central theme to *With One Voice* – the bringing together of people from all parts of society – this includes people who are financially well-off and those that perhaps aren't so.

The reality is that each member is able to negotiate their contribution and the mantra here is;

“Contribute what you can afford”

We do have some general price points that provide a guide when people are thinking about their personal situations;



As you can see there is a wide range – this is the ‘sliding scale’ we sometimes refer to.

We also encourage people to donate to the Giving Circle as a further way to provide a choir experience for others in their community.

A membership isn't a transaction. You don't get x-amount of choir sessions for your money. Rather we like people to think about their membership in terms of 'My contribution helps my local With One Voice remain viable and assists others to attend as well as myself'.
